# Pupil Equity Fund 2025-26

Our vision at Calderwood Primary is that all pupils, regardless of circumstance, have the opportunities and support they need to learn and achieve. This year, we received approximately £49,000 through the Pupil Equity Fund (PEF). This will be used for staffing, resources, and wider experiences to target attainment and achievement across the following areas:



#### Health and Wellbeing

- Personalised support packages based on individual needs, including use of dedicated regulation spaces.
- Regulation and Wellbeing groups for identified learners, to develop emotional literacy, and confidence and engagement in school.
- Continuation of wider community experiences partnership with other agencies to further develop opportunities for all learners to experience success and develop skills.
- Further developing universal and targeted approaches to supporting attendance.

#### Numeracy and Mathematics

- Targeted early level numeracy booster groups for identified learners.
- Review of core numeracy resources and purchasing of resources to meet the needs of learners with barriers to accessing numeracy learning.

## Literacy and English

- Targeted writing booster groups for identified stages.
- Targeted early level phonics booster groups for identified learners.
- Review of core literacy resources and purchasing of resources to meet the needs of learners with barriers to accessing literacy learning.

### Learner Participation and Engagement

- 2x Pupil Support Workers with a dedicated focus on helping to raise attainment and achievement with identified learners.
- Continued Parent Council support (Halloween swap shop, supporting cost of the school day with financial support for trips and events.)
- Life skills and alternative curriculum for those learners who require a unique way to learn.
- Continue to develop our Sustainability Station within the school and nursery to provide food, clothing, advice/support to our families.
- Identified learners' participation in Hi5 achievement award programme.
